The Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBB) is a new federal program that provides eligible households a direct payment of up to \$50 per month toward their internet bill, and a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet.

IT'S QUICK AND EASY!

STEP 1: CHECK YOUR ELIGIBILITY STATUS

Does anyone in your household attend **Chicago Public Schools**? You are eligible!

Other qualifications for EBB include...

- Income-based federal benefits like SNAP, SSI, federal public housing assistance, or Medicaid.
- The federal Pell Grant program for the current school year.
- Substantial loss of income due to job loss or furlough since February 29, 2020.
