

YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE \$50/MONTH OFF YOUR INTERNET BILL!

The **Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBB)** is a new federal program that provides eligible households a direct payment of **up to \$50 per month toward their internet bill**, and a **one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet.**

IT'S QUICK AND EASY!

STEP 1: CHECK YOUR ELIGIBILITY STATUS

Does anyone in your household attend **Chicago Public Schools**?
You are eligible!

Other qualifications for EBB include...

- Income-based **federal benefits** like SNAP, SSI, federal public housing assistance, or Medicaid.
- The federal **Pell Grant** program for the current school year.
- **Substantial loss of income** due to job loss or furlough since February 29, 2020.

STEP 2: CALL THE EBB SUPPORT CENTER

Call the EBB Support Center at **833-511-0311** or visit **GetEmergencyBroadband.org** to apply for the benefit

STEP 3: CONTACT YOUR INTERNET PROVIDER

If you already have internet, **contact your provider** (Xfinity, AT&T, RCN, T-Mobile, etc.) directly to learn about their application process.
